NEGOTIATION AND FAIRNESS

- Seeking mutually satisfying resolutions to conflict
- accepting change
- being willing to compromise

NON-THREATENING BEHAVIOR

- Talking and acting so that she feels safe and comfortable expressing herself and doing things.

ECONOMIC PARTNERSHIP

- Making money decisions together • making sure both partners benefit from financial arrangements

RESPECT

- Listening to her non-judgmentally
- being emotionally affirming and understanding
- valuing opinions

SHARED RESPONSIBILITY

- Mutually agreeing on a fair distribution of work • making family decisions together.

TRUST AND SUPPORT

- Supporting her goals in life
- respecting her right to her own feelings, friends, activities and opinions

RESPONSIBLE PARENTING

- Sharing parental responsibilities • being a positive non-violent role model for the children

HONESTY & ACCOUNTABILITY

- Accepting responsibility for self • acknowledging past use of violence
- admitting being wrong
- communicating openly and truthfully
